

AVON LOOP  
LANDSCAPE DETAILED DESIGN  
LEGEND

- A** Tautahi Pa/The Bricks Minor works around the existing bricks cairn.
- B** Western Gateway Oxford Terrace will end in a circular turning head opposite Willow Street.
- C** Threshold paving provides a gateway transition to the shared path for cyclists and pedestrians. This will include seating and signage.
- D** Boardwalk/Picnic Area This is a quiet, restful area on the Avon River providing respite from the busy arterial roads at either end.
- E** Heritage Pump Station This is outside of the Avon Loop scope of works.
- F** Re-vegetation is proposed along the river margins to enhance ecological values. The planting will strengthen and build on the existing indigenous vegetation patterns.
- G** This location, handy to Fitzgerald Avenue, commemorates the former Avon and Union rowing clubs in the area with a new boat launch platform.
- H** A 2.0m wide Aggrok path provides a connection to Fitzgerald Avenue, providing a sightline to the foreseeable City to Sea Path.
- I** Eastern Gateway / Carpark includes parking with generous width for transporting boats.
